



HUSBAND ATTACKS WIFE WITH ACID **LHC DISPOSES OFF THE MATTER**

LAHORE, FEB 08, 2014:

Lahore High Court (LHC) Complaint Cell has disposed off a notice “husband attacked wife with acid” as complete police report of the case has been submitted in the Anti-Terrorism Court Faisalabad and no further directions are required by the Cell on administrative side.

According to details, Asad Ali, a resident of Woddan village, had stopped wife from visiting relatives but she did not. Asad beat her up and also doused with acid. The victim was taken to District Headquarters Hospital Jhang where her condition was critical, reportedly.

On a press report LHC **Complaint Cell** took cognizance of the issue and directed District & Sessions Judge Jhang to probe into the incident and submit a detailed report as to the steps taken by the police along with his own comments so as to reach Lahore High Court within a week. The said D&SJ reported that a criminal case was registered at Qadirpur police station against Asad Ali for throwing acid. Police report u/s 173 Cr.P.C was submitted in the Court of competent jurisdiction where trial was conducted. The victim also appeared before the D&SJ, Jhang and got recorded her statement to the effect that no acid was thrown upon her by her husband and it was hot water and all that happened due to misunderstanding. Furthermore, she had also forgiven the accused in the name of Almighty Allah. On basis of above, as needful has been done Complaint Cell disposed off the notice into the matter. **(MEDIA CELL)**
