MULTAN HIGH COURT BAR CALLS **ON THE CHIEF JUSTICE**

Chief Justice of Lahore High Court, Mr. Justice Umar Ata Bandial has said that Holy Quran commands rule of law and enforcement of Constitution. Hon'ble Chief Justice was talking to a delegation of Multan High Court Bar Association led by its President Muhammad Shahbaz Rizvi Advocate in his chamber today.

Hon'ble Chief Justice said that our faith demands supremacy of law and there was complete breakdown of the system in the absence of rule of law and dispensation of justice. Hon'ble Chief Justice observed that legal fraternity was lucky in the sense that its bread and butter was linked to the resolving of problems of the aggrieved persons. They always remember and pay esteem respect on the redress of their controversies. Hon'ble Chief Justice appreciated the role of Multan High Court Bar Association and said that not a single conflicting issue was raised in their tenure. "The tradition of boycott of courts and day to day strikes on trivial issues was dying since the last one and a half years", Hon'ble Chief Justice concluded.
