ACCUSED WHO BURNT WIFE WITH **ACID BEHIND BARS** **LHC DISPOSES OFF THE MATTER**

LAHORE, MARCH 14, 2014:

Lahore High Court Complaint Cell has disposed off its notice “husband attacked wife with acid over domestic issues” as the accused has been sent to judicial lock up and police report of the case submitted in the Anti-Terrorism Court, Faisalabad.

According to details, Rabia had married Salah ud Din alias Kashi, a resident of Madanpura, some time ago. They quarreled often over trivial matters and Salah ud Din man-handled his wife frequently. One day, Rabia had an argument with his husband, he thrashed her up severely and then threw acid at her. Her neck, chest and chin were the most affected body parts. The woman was taken to General Hospital Ghulam Muhammad Abad but due to her critical condition she was shifted to Allied Hospital Faisalabad.

On a press report LHC Complaint Cell took cognizance of the issue and directed District & Sessions Judge Faisalabad to probe into the incident and submit a detailed report as to the steps taken by the police along with his own comments so as to reach Lahore High Court within a week. The said Sessions Judge reported that Ghulam Muhammad Abad police registered a case against accused Salah-ud-Din, Mst. Sattan Bibi and Mst. Zubaida Bibi for throwing acid on Mst. Rabia Bibi. Culprit Salah-ud-Din was arrested and sent to jail whereas the other accused had got pre-arrest bail by the trial court. Police report u/s 173 Cr.P.C. against all the accused has also been submitted in the Court of Law, where the case is under trial. Resultantly, no further directions are required by the Cell on administrative side. **(MEDIA CELL)**
