



## **ACCUSED SETTING YOUTH ON** **FIRE BEHIND BARS** **LHC DISPOSES OFF THE MATTER**

**LAHORE, MARCH 24, 2014:**

Lahore High Court Complaint Cell has disposed off its notice “26-year-old boy was set on fire on rejecting advances” as police report against the accused has been submitted in the concerned court of law.

According to details, Sabir Ali, a resident of Chak 66-JB, told police that two unidentified men stopped him on his way home. They took him to a dera, where they tried to convince him on having physical relation with them. He said when he refused advances and tried to skip, they over powered him and sprinkled kerosene oil on him, one of them set him ablaze and fled away locking the door from outside. A passer-by heard him shouting for help and rescued him.

On a press report LHC Complaint Cell took cognizance of the issue and directed District & Sessions Judge Faisalabad to probe into the incident and submit a detailed report as to the steps taken by the police along with his own comments so as to reach Lahore High Court within a week. The Sessions Judge reported that Thikariwala police had registered a case against accused Muhammad Imran, arrested and lodged him in the judicial lockup. Police report u/s 173 Cr.P.C. against him had also been submitted in the Court of Law where the case is under trial. **(MEDIA CELL)**
