



ACCUSED WHO ASSAULTED MINOR
BEHIND BARS
LHC DISPOSES OFF THE MATTER

LAHORE, MARCH 27, 2014:

Lahore High Court Complaint Cell has disposed off its notice “assault on a ten-year-old minor girl in Garh Maharaja” as the accused has been arrested and police report against the accused has been submitted in the court of Additional District & Sessions Judge for adjudication.

According to details, in village Hassu Baleel, daughter of a labourer, a student of 6th class was playing outside her house when accused Siddique and his two accomplices abducted and took her to an unknown place where they molested her. When she became unconscious, they threw her at a deserted place and fled away.

On a press report LHC Complaint Cell took cognizance of the issue and directed District & Sessions Judge Jhang to probe into the incident and submit a detailed report as to the steps taken by the police along with his own comments so as to reach Lahore High Court within a week. The said Sessions Judge reported that Garh Maharaja police registered a case of said occurrence, arrested Muhammad Saddique and sent him to judicial lockup. Police report u/s 173 Cr.P.C. against him had also been submitted in the Court of Law where the case is under trial. **(MEDIA CELL)**

LHC NOTICE:
PROTEST AGAINST POLICE
TORTURE

LAHORE, MARCH 26, 2014

On Wednesday, Lahore High Court Complaint Cell took notice of a press report on administrative side that a man along with other area people staged a protest against police torture.

The Cell has directed the District & Sessions Judge, Faisalabad to look into the matter and submit a detailed report regarding steps taken by police along with his own comments within a week.

According to details, Uzma Bibi, wife of Abrar, had submitted an application with the Samundri City police against four people including Touseef and Abdul Aleem for registration of a case on charges of kidnapping her insane brother, Zulfiqar. She alleged that the suspects wanted to grab the property of Zulfiqar taking advantage of his mental illness. Abrar said police instead of recovering Zulfiqar registered a cross version and arrested him without any justification. He alleged the policemen had tortured him and demanded recovery of his brother-in-law Zulfiqar. On this, he along with area people staged a demonstration outside the CPO office against alleged police torture. The protestors carried banners against police highhandedness and raised slogans. The victim said the police had released him on orders of the Court and now he would get medico-legal certificate for initiating action against the accused policemen. **(MEDIA CELL)**
