LHC NOTICE:
POLICE TORTURE MURDER
ACCUSED TO DEATH

LAHORE, APRIL 14, 2014:

On Monday, Lahore High Court Complaint Cell took notice of a press report on administrative side that a man allegedly threw acid on his wife over a domestic dispute.

The Cell has directed the District & Sessions Judge, Vehari to look into the matter and submit a detailed report regarding steps taken by police along with his own comments within a week.

According to details, A man allegedly threw acid on his wife over a dispute at Chak 517-EB in Burewala, about 50 kilometres from here, on Saturday.

Reports reaching here said M. Husain, a labourer, was not happy with his wife and the couple would often quarrel. On Saturday, Husain beat up his wife and threw acid on her.

Critically injured, the woman was admitted to Vehari's District Headquarters Hospital.

Dr Nasir Lodhi and Dr Naheed Malik examined the victim and said over 50 to 60 per cent of her face and the right side of the body had been affected. Dr Nasir said the woman would be referred to Nishtar Hospital, Multan.

Burewala Sadar Station House Officer Aslam Cheema told this correspondent a case had been registered under Sections 336 and of 7 Anti-Terrorism Act.

District Police Officer Sadiq Ali Dogar said the police had arrested Husain. **(MEDIA CELL)**
