LHC NOTICE:

ASSAULT ON WOMEN IN

THREE DISTRICTS

LAHORE, MAY 06, 2014:

On Tuesday, Lahore High Court Complaint Cell took notice of a press report on administrative side regarding three different incidents of assault on four women.

The Cell has directed the District & Sessions Judges, Okara, Pakpattan & Toba Tek Singh to look into the matter and submit detailed reports regarding steps taken by police along with their own comments within a week.

According to details, a woman was going to see her sister in Okara when Muhammad Sadiq, resident of village Gogera enticed her and took to a deserted place where he threatened the woman and molested her. Meanwhile, in village Arazi Amer Singh of Pakpattan, a minor girl, student to class-V was playing outside her house when accused Asif Cheema and Asghar Bhutta forcefully took her in nearby fields and tried to assault her. On hearing the cries of the girl, the villagers gathered and caught one Asif Cheema and handed over to police whereas Asghar managed to escape. Police registered the case but could not arrest the other culprit. Victim's parents alleged that investigation officer, ASI Muhammad Sharif was pressuring them for striking down a settlement. Similarly, two sisters, resident of Chak No. 761/GB of Kamalia were coming home after visiting their relatives when accused Javed and Aslam kidnapped and took them at their dera where they sexually harassed them. Police registered a case and started investigations. **(MEDIA CELL)**
