**LANDLORDS ACCUSED OF UNLEASHING  
DOGS ON YOUTH BEHIND BARS  
LHC DISPOSES OFF THE MATTER**

**LAHORE, MAY 08, 2014:**

Lahore High Court Complaint Cell has disposed off a notice regarding unleashing dogs on an 18-year-old boy and torturing women by the influential landlords, as they have been arrested and complete police report against them has been submitted in the Court of competent jurisdiction.

According to details, a student of fifth class was kidnapped for ransom from village Jagganwala. A nominated case of abduction was registered against landlords Abdul Jabbar and Abid etc. and Muhammad Asif stood witness in the case. In retaliation, the accused called Qasim, 18, son of the witness at their Dera. They tortured the boy and unleashed dogs on him. The victim was shifted to District Headquarters Hospital. The landlords also beat up the women of the witness family and they got head injuries.

On a press report LHC Complaint Cell had taken cognizance of the issue and directed District & Sessions Judge Hafizabad to probe into the incident and submit a detailed report within a week as to the steps taken by the police along with his own comments. The Sessions Judge reported that police registered a case against two accused Abid and Jabbar and after completion of investigation, police report u/s 173 Cr.P.C. against the culprits had also been submitted in the trial court. Trial court has also been directed to dispose of the case in accordance with law as early as possible. **(MEDIA CELL)**
