



LHC NOTICE:
MAN KILLS WIFE BY FORCING HER
TAKE ACID

LAHORE, MAY 26, 2014:

On Monday, Lahore High Court Complaint Cell took notice of a press report on administrative side that a young woman was killed by husband forcing her to take acid.

The Cell has directed the District & Sessions Judge, Hafizabad to look into the matter and submit detailed report regarding steps taken by police along with his own comments within a week.

According to details, Sobia of Mohallah Hassan Town had contracted marriage with Qamar Shah, resident of Ahmadabad in tehsil Gojra a year ago. Their relations got strained due to regular torture by her spouse even over trivial issues. Hence, she left Qamar's house and started living with her parents in Hafizabad. However, Qamar Shah reconciled with Sobia after sometime and took her back to his house where he allegedly administered acid to her. On receiving information, the victim's parents rushed her to the Allied Hospital Faisalabad where she succumbed to her burns. Later, the body was shifted to the District Headquarters Hospital Hafizabad for autopsy. The police registered a case against accused Qamar and were raiding different places for arrest but in vain. **(MEDIA CELL)**
