SEMINARY TEACHER WHO ASSAULTED
FEMALE STUDENT SENT TO JAIL
LHC DISPOSES OFF THE MATTER

LAHORE, JUNE 06, 2014:

Lahore High Court Complaint Cell has disposed of a notice regarding assault on a 4-year-old seminary student by her teacher in Mailsi, as the accused has been arrested and police report against him has been submitted in the Anti-Terrorism Court, Multan.

According to details, the girl's father, a resident of Nawan Shehr in Mailsi, told police that he had dropped his 4-year-old daughter at the Shaheedanwala Madrassa in the neighborhood. He said more than 70 children from five nearby villages were enrolled at the madrassa. It was the girl's first day and the chief cleric Shah Nawaz had asked him to drop her at his office as the cleric would introduce her to other children. When father of the ill fated girl went to pick her up at noon, he was told that his daughter was in cleric's office. The office was locked and the cleric was missing. He broke into the room and found the child lying unconscious. She was taken to the district headquarters hospital where doctors confirmed sexual abuse.

On a press report LHC Complaint Cell had taken cognizance of the issue and directed District & Sessions Judge Vehari to probe into the incident and submit a detailed report within a week as to the steps taken by the police along with his own comments. The Sessions Judge reported that Miranpur police registered a case against the said culprit and arrested him. Police report u/s 173 Cr.P.C. against said accused had also been submitted in the ATA Court, Multan, where the case is under trial. **(MEDIA CELL)**
