



EX- HUSBAND & IN-LAWS SET DOG ON WOMAN
LHC DISPOSES OFF THE MATTER

LAHORE, JUNE 11, 2014:

Lahore High Court Complaint Cell has disposed of a notice that ex-husband and in-laws set dog on a woman, as the police report against the culprits has been submitted in the trial court.

According to details, a divorced woman, Shehr Bano, along with her mother was going to the Sukheke police station to lodge complaint against her former in-laws regarding a dowry dispute. Near the police station, Bano's former husband and his relatives, including Asif, allegedly unleashed a dog on her.

On a press report LHC Complaint Cell had taken cognizance of the issue and directed District & Sessions Judge Hafizabad to probe into the incident and submit a detailed report within a week as to the steps taken by the police along with his own comments. The Sessions Judge reported that as per report of Lady Doctor, the injuries of complainant are the result of fall on the ground and not the result of biting of dog. The DPO, Hafizabad has further narrated that after completion of investigation, police report u/s 173 Cr.P.C. against the arrested accused persons namely Rashid and Asif had also been submitted in the Court of competent jurisdiction where the case is under trial. Sessions Judge further directed the trial to dispose of the case on merits in accordance with law as early as possible. **(MEDIA CELL)**
