



ACID ATTACK VICTIM DIES AT HOSPITAL
LHC DISPOSES OFF THE MATTER

LAHORE, JUNE 12, 2014:

Lahore High Court Complaint Cell has disposed of a notice a man attacked with acid died at Hospital, as the accused persons have been arrested and police report against them has been submitted in the Anti Terrorism Court, Multan.

According to details, the deceased, Muhammad Zahid, 21, resident of Galleywal in Lodhran district, was being treated for acid burns. He had been attacked by his paternal uncle, Abdul Majeed. According to police, Majeed wanted his 44-year-old daughter to marry Zahid. When Zahid refused the proposal, his relations with his uncle deteriorated. On this, Majeed invited Zahid to his house and again asked him to marry his daughter when Zahid refused to do so he tied him up and threw acid on him. Zahid was taken to Bahawal Victoria hospital where he was found to have lost his eyes and sustained 80 per cent burns.

On a press report LHC Complaint Cell had taken cognizance of the issue and directed District & Sessions Judge Lodhran to probe into the incident and submit a detailed report within a week as to the steps taken by the police along with his own comments. The Sessions Judge reported that Galleywal police registered a case against Abdul Majeed and Abdul Rasheed and arrested them. After completion of investigation they had been sent to judicial lock up and police report u/s 173 Cr.P.C. against them had also been submitted in the Anti Terrorism Court, Multan, where the case is under trial. **(MEDIA CELL)**
